

## March 10<sup>th</sup> Neighborhood Watch Log

- 16 Attendees including Sgt. Routh – including 2 new members
- Hazelwood Police trivia event
- Patrol Logs – not much participation. Reviewing the purpose and benefits.
- Liquor Store Updates – ratios, check cashing, etc. Code enforcement has taken them to court again. Contacted Russell Todd
- No Trespassing signs – there are a lot of benefits including giving notice of trespassing and keeping people out of buildings they aren't welcome in
- A long time ago, there was a volunteer that locked the doors at 6pm every night – if we wanted that we would have to make sure people could get out due to fire code
- To put in a no trespassing charge, someone has to testify in court – they're willing to come up every day. The no trespassing signs could \*probably\* go on the address signs. State ordinance must be every 100 feet and can't be over 7 ft. tall. City ordinance doesn't say that – it says, must be prominently displayed.
- 8756 – shared hallway – would like pushbars from the inside with locks on the outside – potentially key codes on outside non-electronic
- Whoever is designated to attend court would need to sign the complaint and attend the court meeting
- Mentioned neighborhood watch signs for \$1
- Mentioned the Breaking and Entering on the 20<sup>th</sup> of Feb. in the middle of the day – 11:21am
- Bruce mentioned a suspicious character that he called the police on
- Mentioned attempted break-in @ the Mills
- Talked about not leaving things in vehicles visibly
- Discussed walking group – flashlights, cell phone, mace, etc. – go in a group of 4 or more – coordinate outfits/shirts/etc. – bright colors – giving out t-shirts as an incentive
- Sports Energizers: 423-6000 for t-shirts, etc. – Sgt. Routh contact
- Discussed a clean-up effort
- Potential to video-tape, warn them that we're watching them, sending a certified letter to let them know, let them know we will have them arrested and prosecute
- Granada residents also visit the liquor store – if we could set up a boycott, that would be good
- Casino Night – Bruce Volunteers, another BBQ, K9 attack, pot-luck
- Opening pool – raise funds for the pool by having a party on a Saturday – hot dogs, pop-up tent, sides, soda with some price of entry
- Recommendation to improve playground – it collects water when raining and is wet in the playground area
- Spoke about benches
- Logs help to find cars out of the ordinary – police can run the plates
- Any way to keep children from riding bicycles and playing in the parking lot
- Action Items: Patrol Log and Talk to Neighbors about Neighborhood Watch and Sgt. Routh action item: set up building-specific meetings
- Discussed wanting to have renters participate as much as possible
- Board will subsidize some signs possibly – bulletin boards possibly
